

# PARKING

Dear Family Members & Visitors to Mount St. Mary Hospital,

We are quite aware of the parking challenges you have when coming to visit your loved ones at Mount St. Mary, and the situation is not unlike many other organizations, businesses and homes in our location with regard to lack of available parking spaces. The problem is now compounded by the City of Victoria installing parking meters on Humboldt Street.

We are able to offer free two-hour parking at the entrance to our building:

- 2 Visitor parking spaces; and
- 1 Disabled Visitor parking space.

The misuse of the driveway and parking at the entrance to the building has become a safety risk and violates compliance with the Fire Marshall regulations. Non-compliance with the following safety regulations **AT ALL TIMES** will result in consequences including towing of the offending vehicle:

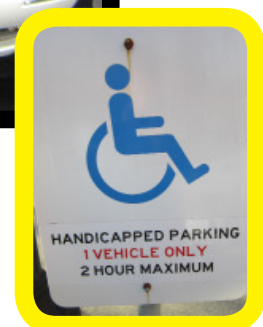
1. ONLY 1 vehicle may be parked in the Disabled Visitor space at any one time for a two hour maximum.
2. ALL vehicles are to park in Visitors parking spaces ONLY for a two-hour maximum.
